

2022 WSCCA Senior Scholarship GENERAL INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. One year, non-renewable scholarship.
2. \$25,000 worth of scholarships will be awarded ranging from \$1,000-\$5,000 each. Number of scholarships to be determined by scholarships committee.
3. Applicant's Head Coach must be a member of the WSCCA. Members can be found at www.wscca.com under Membership.
4. Applicant must be a Senior graduating in June 2022
5. Applicant must have a cumulative overall 3.0 GPA
6. Applicant must complete the online application with all required documents (see materials section below)
7. Any part of the application or information incompletely or incorrectly submitted will render the application ineligible.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. The WSCCA Scholarship Committee will review eligible applications and select the scholarship recipient.
2. Applicants will be notified by email if they are a scholarship recipient.
3. **The Scholarship recipients will be announced at the Coaches Conference on May 21, 2022**
4. If a recipient does not attend college or vocational school, the scholarship will be forfeited to an alternate.
5. The scholarship expires one year from the applicant's graduation date. If not claimed by that date, monies will go back into the WSCCA general scholarship fund.
6. Applications become property of the WSCCA.

GUIDELINES FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION MATERIALS

New! This year application will be submitted entirely online. Please note some items will need to be scanned and uploaded.

STEP 1: Fill out Application

STEP 2: Upload a 45sec-1min Video Resume via a YouTube link which includes a self-introduction and description of extra curriculars, AP/Honors classes (if applicable), job (if applicable), and any additional information that may be relevant to the application.

STEP 3: Upload ESSAY – *Life Skills Learned Through Cheerleading*
Tahoma, 12 pt. double spaced, 2 pages

STEP 4: Upload *Post Graduation Plans*

What are they, how do you plan to accomplish them and how will this scholarship assist in accomplishing these goals? Tahoma, 12 pt. double spaced, 1 page maximum

STEP 5: Upload Letter of Recommendation from Cheerleading Coach

STEP 6: Upload Letter of Recommendation from High School Teacher, Counselor or Administrator

STEP 7: Upload Official School Transcript

STEP 8: Upload Copy of Senior Class Schedule
