The 2022 All-State competition will be two parts; preliminary and finals. All athletes can participate in the preliminary virtual portion. The top percentage in each division will be invited to the in-person competition at Emerald Ridge High School on March 19th.

Those advancing to the finals will be notified via email the week of March 6th.

Programs may enter as many athletes as they want to participate. There is no limit of athletes per program for the 2022 All State Competition. All initial submissions are to be sent via video submission and will be judged remotely. Video submissions are due February 25th.

All submissions (except stunt group) must submit a complete video in the following order:

Jump

Cheer

Dance

Tumbling

Stunt groups should submit a video following the exact order of the 8-count sheet.

The WSCCA All State event is open to all school and recreational cheerleaders.

Spectators may attend the in-person competition on March 19th. Spectator cost is \$5. There may be one coach admitted for free per every 5 participants with a max of three coaches.
